Please refrain from visiting the museum if you have any of the following:

- ✓ A fever over 37.5°C (99.5°F)
- ✓ Cold-like symptoms, such as coughing, sneezing, running nose, or sore throat
- ✓ Have been in close contact with a COVID-19 infected person
- ✓ If you are within the health observation time period following such contact or travelling from a country with elevated COVID-19 infection rates

Please Follow the Instructions Below:

- Please practice good etiquette by wearing a mask, refraining from coughing near others, and washing and disinfecting your hands.
- Body temperatures will be taken at the entrance to the museum. Visitors who are found to have a fever of 37.5°C (99.5F) or higher will be refused entry.

- Please do not touch exhibits, display cases, or devices that are not in use.
- Please try to stay at least 2 meters (or approx. 7 feet) away from other visitors inside the museum.
- Please refrain from talking loudly in the exhibition rooms.

- Staff members conduct daily temperature checks and confirm that they are in good health.
- All staff members wear masks or face shields.
- Acrylic panels are installed at counters.
- Disinfectant is placed at the entrance to the museum.
- Thorough cleaning, disinfection, and ventilation is practiced inside the building.
- Coordination with the public health authorities will occur if visitors or staff members develop symptoms associated with COVID-19.
